




We will get off at the Jervis Stop when we travel to 14 Henrietta Street on the Luas red line.

We will walk towards the nearest entrance of the Jervis shopping centre and turn right onto Jervis Street.



As we walk along Jervis Street, we will pass Wolfe Tone Square, a small public park on our left hand side.


We continue up this road, crossing Mary Street and keeping Toymaster and Smyth's Toys on our left until we get to the top of Jervis Street where it meets Parnell Street



When we get to the top of Jervis Street we will see Penny's on the corner and a cinema on the opposite side of the road. We will take a right turn, passing the entrance to Penny's, towards the pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights.



When it is safe to do so, we will cross the road. A large Euro Giant shop is on our left. We continue on this path, passing a car park, a café and Bolton Street DIT as we walk up King's Inns Street.



We will arrive at the junction of Bolton Street. There is a pedestrian crossing straight ahead, outside a Spar shop. We cross the road here to Henrietta Street. The King's Inn pub will be on our right hand side.

As we walk past the Spar, keeping the King's Inn on our left, we will see colourful bollards outside of number 14. You are now at the Museum.
When you arrive, just give the name your booking is under to the person at reception. Enjoy the tour!
